GENERAL INFORMATION

The Bob Travers Student of Integrity Scholarship has been established to:

- Honor the memory of Bob Travers who was a member of the Sienna community, a man of great integrity who took time to reflect and make sure actions were made for the greater good in his personal life as well as in the natural gas industry
- Recognize high school seniors who personify values of leadership and integrity that Mr. Travers exemplified courage, honor, humility, respect, compassion
- Emphasize the importance of ethical behavior, community service, and academic accomplishments

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Qualifies as a high school senior
- Plans to continue education after high school graduation
- Attends Ridge Point High School

AWARDS & JUDGING CRITERIA

One \$1000 SCHOLARSHIP will be presented to a Ridge Point High School graduating senior.

Scholarship recipients will be selected by a committee at Todd Harmon Orthodontics based on the following criteria:

- Essay content = 50%
- Community service = 20%
- Leadership = 20%
- Recommendations = 5%
- Academic = 5%

The name of the scholarship winner will be announced by Todd Harmon Orthodontics in May 2020. The student will be officially recognized in the media and at the Ridge Point High School Awards Ceremony held at Ridge Point High School in May 14, 2020.

Scholarship funds will be distributed directly to the post-secondary institution upon verification of enrollment. Scholarship must be applied toward tuition and/or room and board.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Entries must be submitted as a package and include all of the items listed below. Each item should be labeled and typed on a separate 8.5" x 11" sheet of paper.

Scholarship Award Checklist:
A. Application Form
B. Description of school-related extracurricular activities: include awards/honors/offices held
C. Description of participation in any work experiences, community activities and/or organizational participation: include awards/honors/offices held
D. Two letters of recommendation: one from a school official and one from an employer, community leader, or a representative of a religious institution – the Recommendation form may be accessed at www.toddharmonorthodontics.com on the "Giving Back" page
 You send the link to the people who are recommending you, and they can fill it out, print it and give it to you for submission with the rest of your application materials or You send the link to the people who are recommending you, and they can write their own recommendation in a separate letter, attach it to the Recommendation Form and give it to you for submission with the rest of your application materials.
E. Description of post-secondary education plans
F. Provide one of the following:
 A photocopy of the most recent transcript A photocopy of ACT or SAT score
G. Response to the following essay topic: single spaced, 12 point Times New Roman font, 1" margins and approximately 500 words in length
Essay: Define what Integrity means to you and discuss an ethical dilemma you've encountered. Be sure to include specific examples of how the matter affected you and others. Explain how your sense of ethics,
